Chapter Opening

Oziel Grand Chapter will resume in-person meetings effective January 3, 2022. As a body, the following guidelines are to be followed Statewide.

Chapter Meetings

- 1. A sign-in book must be maintained by each Chapter, tracking all members who are in physical attendance for the chapter meeting. Chapters are NOT to exceed the building/room in-person capacity.
- 2. Each chapter will purchase and maintain a digital thermometer for the taking of the temperatures of ALL participants who are attending their chapter meetings.
- 3. Temperature checks must be taken of all members who are attending the meeting in person and will be taken prior to the members' entrance into the chapter room. Utilize the self-assessment form to document temperature checks.
- 4. Plain white, black, or disposable surgical masks MUST be worn during the entire meeting unless the Sister/Brother is actively speaking. (No OES or Masonic Symbols or references are permitted on the masks.)
- 5. Chapters MUST have extra masks on site along with ample hand sanitizer, hand washing soap, and paper towels.
- 6. All Chapters MUST be Opened and Closed in due Ritualistic Form with a MINIMUM of SEVEN (7) Members of that particular Chapter being present. The following seven seats must be filled:
 - a. Worthy Matron
 - b. Worthy Patron
 - c. Associate Matron
 - d. One Conductress (either the Conductress or Associate Conductress)
 - e. Secretary
 - f. Esther
 - g. Warder/Sentinel A Brother should be the Sentinel, however, if there is only one (1) Brother present at the Chapter meeting, a Sister can fill in this position.
- 7. The PASS will be taken orally from the members prior to their entrance into the Chapter Room after their Temperature is taken. There will be NO Touching, and the Grip will NOT be taken. **Social Distancing will be strictly observed.**
- 8. The Verbiage for the Opening of the Chapter will be strictly followed as outlined in the Oziel Grand Chapter OES Ritual, **OPENING CEREMONIES WITHOUT LINE OF MARCH**, Pages 73-74 (Copyright 2014). The Conductress and the Associate Conductress will meet the Worthy Matron in the West, and escort her through the Star on the Northside of the Altar to the East, walking in a single file, observing social distancing, with no physical contact.
- 9. The taking of the Pass and Grip, as outlined in the OES Ritual, will be recited from the Opening as a formality, but the Pass will be given prior to the entrance into the chapter room, and again the Grip will NOT be taken from any Member by any Chapter Member. (the Sentinel, Warder or Conductresses)
- 10. The Ritualistic Opening will resume except for taking the Pass.
- 11. After the Ritualistic Opening is completed, the Chapter will then host a hybrid virtual Business Meeting. The virtual meeting is to begin after the Ritualistic Chapter Opening is concluded and must conclude prior to the Ritualistic OES Chapter Closing.
- 12. The Ritualistic Chapter Opening and Closing is NOT to be Recorded!
- 13. All participants attending the chapter meeting virtually MUST be properly dressed, either as an Eastern Star or a Master Mason, and fully regaled in proper Eastern Star regalia.
- 14. All Chapter Members attending their chapter meeting virtually MUST be situated in a private setting (a private place, space or area), and they MUST have their video camera feature on at all times.
- 15. At the conclusion of each Chapter Meeting, the completed Chapter attendance record (with the Temperature Checks) for all the Onsite/In Person participants must be forwarded to the District Deputy Grand Matron of that respective district, within twenty-four (24) hours.

- 16. All unvaccinated Members of the Order and those unable to wear a mask during the entire meeting are strongly encouraged to only attend the Virtual OES Chapter Meetings, if possible.
- 17. These guidelines will be in effect from Saturday, January 1, 2022, through Thursday, June 30, 2022.
- 18. All meeting requests after Friday, July 1, 2022, will require a dispensation from the Office of the Grand Worthy Patron.
- 19. The proper record keeping (contact tracing), and temperature checks of ALL participants must be observed by All Chapters amenable to Oziel Grand Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star, Prince Hall Affiliation, Jurisdiction of New Jersey, for all Chapter Meetings, Chapter Social Affairs/Events and Chapter Charitable Events.

Chapter School of Instruction

- Meetings can be held virtual.
- No Signs and Passes are to be given, if Virtual
- The Worthy Matrons will provide instructions to members for attending Chapter Schools of Instruction via the Virtual Platform.

District School of Instruction

- District Schools of Instructions can remain virtual.
- Business Casual Attire is to be observed.
- No Signs and Passes are to be given.
- Prior to the meeting, the Worthy Patrons will be informed of the topic that will be covered at District School of Instruction and will notify their members.
- The District Deputy Grand Matrons will provide instructions and/or clarifications for attending District Schools of Instructions via the Virtual Platform.

Sisters and Brothers remember that virtual and teleconference calls are considered an official meeting, thus Zoom etiquette guidelines and dress codes apply to all. These guidelines are subject to change depending on CDC and the Department of Health guidelines.

2021-2023 Administration Initiatives:

Finances: Various Virtual Workshops are planned for members of Oziel Grand Chapter to obtain useful information On financial management and investments for the future.

Outreach: Oziel Grand Chapter will continue to partner with non-profit organizations to assist individuals in improving their lives.

Domestic Violence: Oziel Grand Chapter will partner with a non-profit organization to increase knowledge and awareness of Domestic Violence. Sister Ruby L. Thomas, Worthy Matron of Aaron Chapter No. 8 will be spearheading this important initiative.

Membership: The Chapters of Oziel Grand Chapter will reclaim members of the past while embracing members of the future.

Youth: Oziel Grand Chapter will continue its support of the Youth Felicitares.

Cancer Awareness: Oziel Grand Chapter will partner with a non-profit organization to gain insight about cancer awareness (prostate, breast)

LUPUS: Oziel Grand Chapter will partner with a non-profit organization to gain awareness; this disease affects a large number of our members.

Multiple Sclerosis: Oziel Grand Chapter will partner with a non-profit organization to gain insight into awareness.

Annual Oziel Secretary and Treasurer workshop:

A Virtual Secretary and Treasurer workshop was conducted on Saturday, October 16, 2021. It was imperative that those in a leadership capacity and the Chapter's fiscal Officers attended, in order that they remain in sync with the day-to-day operations of their Chapter.

Chapter Date Request:

Chapter Annual Affair dates have been approved, events that may be forthcoming must be forwarded to Sister Martha J. Meyers, PDDGM, Date Clearance, and Sister Leslie VanPutten, PM, Administrative Assistant to the 51st Grand Worthy Matron, through your District Deputy Grand Matron. All chapter-sponsored events must have the approval of the 51st Grand Worthy Matron before the communication of the event is posted. Following the review of the date and nature of said event by the 51st Grand Worthy Matron, final approval shall be granted by the District Deputy Grand Master of your respective District.

Communications:

Chapter communications shall be read in the following order:

- 1. Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge
- 2. Oziel Grand Chapter
- 3. Subordinate Chapters
- 4. Subordinate Lodges
- 5. Other Masonic Houses
- 6. Miscellaneous

Communications from the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge and Oziel Grand Chapter <u>MUST BE READ</u> in its entirety. Do not summarize. It is, however, permissible to summarize all other communications.

Dispensations:

Upon the vote of the Chapter, all requests for dispensations involving ritualistic work shall be forwarded to the Grand Worthy Patron, through the District Deputy Grand Matron, with the appropriate fees attached. All requests to change a meeting date, time or location must be made through the form of a dispensation. The current fee for a dispensation, as denoted in the Grand Chapter By-Laws, is five (\$5.00) dollars. A dispensation MUST BE READ immediately following the ritualistic opening before the transaction of business for which the dispensation was requested.

District Meetings:

During this Administration, Districts will host their Annual District Meeting on a Friday evening or Saturday morning. Detailed information and dates will be forthcoming.

Education and Scholarship:

This administration will continue supporting the "Change for Education" Initiative. All contributions are used to aid high school students who are in need of financial support to further their education. All funds collected for the

"Change for Education are to be forwarded to Sis. Jessi A. Banks, Grand Financial Secretary, immediately following the April 2022 Chapter meeting.

Official Visitations:

District Deputy Grand Matrons and the Grand District Lecturers will make their official visit to each Chapter within the District, during the administrative year. The Grand Worthy Matron and Grand Worthy Patron shall complete their schedule of official visits to each Chapter within the 2021-2023 Administrative period. When the Grand Worthy Matron and Grand Worthy Patron are scheduled for an official visit, the District Deputy Grand Matron and Grand District Lecturer shall make their official visit one month prior. At the time of each official visitation, please have all Secretary and Treasurer's ledgers, vouchers and bank statements available for review.

Out-of-State Visits and Affiliation Requests:

Out-of-State visits and Affiliation requests either in-person or via a Virtual Platform are to be made **IN WRITING** and forwarded to the Grand Worthy Matron through the District Deputy Grand Matron. All requests must be approved by the Grand Worthy Matron.

Visits by members from other Jurisdictions are permissible at this time. We ask that you continue to pray for our Sister Jurisdictions.

Oziel Grand Chapter Charity Foundation:

For those who shop online with Amazon, we ask you to consider selecting Oziel Grand Chapter Charity Foundation as your charity of choice. Solicitation:

Elliott, 51st Grand Worthy Matron." Solicitations from other Houses will read, "Authorization for this Solicitation has been granted by Sister Rochelle M. Elliott, 51st Grand Worthy Matron." If the solicitation statement is not at the top of the letter, the communication cannot be read. Solicitation requests from sources other than the Prince Hall Family must be approved by the Grand Worthy Matron, prior to being read in the Chapter room.

<u>Statewide Solicitation</u> permitted for Chapter Annual Affair Limited Solicitation for all other Chapter events.

Formal invitations are to be forwarded to the invited guests at least 60 days prior to the event.

The Oziel Grand Chapter Ritual is available at a cost of \$20.00. Prices of supplies are subject to change.
